The environment is at the heart of the reflections of the field, to move in direction of a more responsible and sustainable Tourism. New provisions are being put in place to mix accessible ski to the greatest number and respect for the environment.

GREEN ENERGY

A new partnership for CO² impact reduction

This winter, the ski lift companies of Les Sybelles are committed to a sustainable approach to reduce their CO² emissions by now exclusively sourcing renewable energies. A partnership between EDF and the ski lift companies of Sybelles makes it possible to cover in "green" energies (hydroelectric, solar and wind) all the energy needs necessary for the production of artificial snow and the operation of ski lifts. Energy is certified 100% renewable.



RELIEVE ON TREES AND YOUNG GENERATIONS

The Sybelles ski area supports the *Nebeday* association in Senegal, which is struggling to reforest agricultural areas that are drying up and the resource is running out. In collaboration with schools of the country, 50 000 trees will be planted this year by young Senegalese. The target is double: to bring well-being to the people of Senegal, where temperatures are already increase, and to awareness of younger generations. In addition to the 50 000 trees, the Sybelles ski area will contribute to strengthening the ecosystem with 90 000 plantations in the mangrove zone.

A philosophy that the Sybelles wish to transpose to its visitors.

Young connected ski area in France, Les Sybelles want to be territory of reference for ski learning. With 7 approved centers for hosting snow classes, Les Sybelles trains skiers of tomorrow. This winter, in addition to learning to slide, the ski area wants to make its contribution to the awareness of children in ecology. A tree planting kit will be offered to all children staying in the ski resorts.

DURABLES BEDS

Offer financially accessible and restorable accommodation.

The residence MMV « Etoile des Sybelles » in le Corbier **will be the first building of 8 floors and 99 apartments entirely built by modular block wood**, renewable material, by the partner Ossabois. Real laboratory of modular construction in station, the **off-site and renewable materials manufacturing allows to realize a saving of 30% of CO² emission** compared to a traditional construction. In addition, the modules built in factories in the Auvergne Rhône-Alpes region also make it possible to optimize the materials used and reduce waste by 30 to 40%.

The financial project is part of a sustainable vision.

The building will be dedicated to tourism exploitation for the next 30 years. The opening is scheduled for December 2020, just one year after the start of beginning construction.
